

# EU: A world of alliances, initiatives and platforms..





#### Important ingredients to succeed in Europe:







- Underestimating your competences/asset is not an option
- Identify your community/action and invest in entering
- Give yourself time before having significant returns (1-2 years at least)

### **Example of Local vs Global**

- Preparatory Support and Transfer Actions (Technology Transfer initiative led by the EC some years ago prodromic to the current Digital Innovation Hubs)
- Successfully implemented a Finnish Technology in Italy through engagement of local experts
- Today this is a product on the market

Success factor: the network of reference of the initiative allowing to valorise local competences giving the European Dimension

#### **Final consideration**

National ecosystemic approach (collaboration with industry and R&D stakeholders) is key to generate and nurture knowledge and excellence Active engagement at European level in relevant initiatives/networks is fundamental to crossfertilise knowledge and keep excellence high
