## What is ERA\_FABRIC

The ERA\_FABRIC project aims to develop and test the **ERA Hubs concept** across different geographies and structures in Europe, based on common compliance criteria and promoting an open, efficient and inclusive European research and innovation system.

The process acts as an incentive for advanced ecosystems to seek recognition, and for less advanced ecosystems to reach the criteria facilitating support from European, national and regional level.



# ERA\_FABRIC in brief

#### **Main focus**

find ways for better cooperation within and between the regions, identify what is missing, which models and activities already exist, etc. and based on the result create set of recommendations for policy makers.

#### **Final goal**

contributing to the European Research Area and leading to more successful products/services and answers to societal challenges through **better cooperation between science, business, politics**/administration and better **involvement of the civil society**.
